

MEMORIAL ACCLAMATION

Blessed is Jesus Christ, our Savior: On a high mountain you let your glory shine, so that we might see Jesus as he really is: your Chosen and Beloved, our Lord and our God.

With humble gratitude, we remember the night when the darkness of impending death began closing in. Jesus took the bread, blessed and broke it, and gave it to disciples, who had witnessed the glory of his transfiguration and who would soon witness his death, saying: "Take, eat, this is my body, given for you. Do this in remembrance of me."

After supper, Jesus took the cup, blessed it and gave it to his disciples, saying: "Drink from this, all of you. This is my life, poured out for you and for many, for the forgiveness of sins. Do this, as often as your drink it, in remembrance of me."

And so, in remembrance of these, your mighty acts of love and light, we offer ourselves in praise and thanksgiving. As your covenant people and as reflections of your glory, in union with Christ's love for us, we proclaim the mystery of faith:
